Dear Secretary of State,

We are writing to urge you to use your Department's Road Investment Strategy to provide the funding necessary to upgrade Llyncllys Crossroads and make the A483 safer through Pant and Llanymynech.

This stretch of road is used by thousands of vehicles every day of the year but is one of the most dangerous roads in the region and indeed the country.

The A483 is a key arterial route connecting England and Wales and is used by commuters, holidaymakers, hauliers, farmers and families from both sides of the border.

Serious collisions take place here on a regular basis. Many people have been injured in incidents that require police, ambulance, air ambulance and firefighters to respond to.

These crashes have a serious human cost but also a serious economic cost through congestion, delays and the wasted time spent by the many drivers who take lengthy detours to avoid Llyncllys Crossroads entirely.

Meanwhile pedestrians must navigate narrow pavements through Pant, where speeding is a common occurrence and the road is not wide enough for the many large vehicles that travel along it.

School children have no safe way of crossing the road to reach Bryn Offa School or the bus stop next to the White Lion in Llyncllys.

None of these issues are new and all should have been addressed many years ago. You now have the chance to right this wrong and provide the safety measures our communities desperately need.
