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COST OF LIVING



Many families across the UK are now struggling to cope with the cost of living. I have been contacted by lots of residents here in North Shropshire who are finding it difficult to pay the bills.

In Parliament, I supported moves to freeze the energy price cap to prevent residents being hit with even higher bills. Locally, I've been urging Shropshire Council to set up 'community heating hubs' this winter. These would be located in existing public buildings, like leisure centres and libraries, for people who find they can no longer afford to keep their homes warm. This scheme shouldn't have been necessary, but sadly it is.
